#### **Volunteer Job Descriptions**

Thank you for your interest in volunteering, our desire is to help you find a place to serve that matches your gifting and passion. Training will be provided, as needed, to give you a clear understanding of your responsibility and purpose in your chosen area of service.

**Usher:** Serve the basic needs of the people attending NCCC so that they are free to focus on the worship and teachings of Christ at the church services. We do this by: preparing for the people, welcoming and guiding the people, serving them during the service and protecting the service from distractions. Ushers may be asked to pass out bulletins, be an inside usher to minimize distractions and be available to address emergencies, collect offering, count offering and prepare and serve communion.

**Greeter:** Handing out bulletins. Greet and direct all people who come to NCCC services to the love of God. This may be done before, during and after services and is accomplished by personally approaching as many people as possible with an appropriate greeting and answering questions they may have about the church.

**Hospitality Server:** Share the love of Christ with all that come to NCCC through the service of refreshments (food and drink). You are often the first point of contact with newcomers. As you serve you may have opportunity to introduce them to Church leadership, mature Christians and regular attendees of NCCC, answer their questions and direct them to Church resources. Hospitality servers are asked to make coffee, carry heavy containers, prepare food and clean up.

**Prayer Team:** Pray for, listen to and direct the person/persons, who come forward at the end of the church service, to Jesus Christ, who can and will meet their needs; this is accomplished by prayer and direction toward ministries in the church that might be helpful to them.

**Kitchen Angels**: Serving the body of North Coast Calvary through the kitchen. Once a week stock and clean the kitchen. This important behind the scenes job takes as little as 2 hours up to 4 hours as needed.

**Safety Parking Team**: Greet and assist vehicles in parking at NCCC and help answer questions, help the handicapped and report accidents. They can serve at special events as well as at church services.

**Safety Medical Team:** Made up of EMTs, Paramedics, or those with ER experience who attend NCCC regularly. They care deeply about our church and those who are in each service and are ready to assist.

**Safety Team:** Made up of capable, protective and friendly people who assist in making our campus a safe place to be on the weekends. They serve campus wide (not inside the service).

**Safety TAC Team:** Made up primarily of those with law enforcement backgrounds who attend NCCC regularly. Caring deeply about our church, they apply reasonable, basic safety measures to maximize the ministry activities that take place on the campus.
