WEEK 2

DAY 7

Praise (Reflect on what you're grateful for from day 6 with the Lord)

Read the text: Philippians 1:23-26 (Jot down key or repeated words and phrases)

Ask questions & interpret the context:

- How convinced are you that if you departed from this world, you'd be with Christ? (v.23)
- How has the Lord used you even during difficult times in your life to bless others? (vv.24)
- Name someone and then pray for wisdom on how you could encourage that person's spiritual growth. (v.25)

Summarize: Now take a moment to go back and pour over your observations as well as your responses to the questions.

Engage with God: Bring your thoughts, questions, and desire for change to the Lord for his forgiveness, wisdom, correction, guidance, and direction. Her are some extra questions to consider:

- 1. What is the Lord saying to your personally?
- 2. What do you need to pray about?
- 3. With whom does the Lord want you to share this devotional?
- 4. Who has the Lord placed on your heart to pray for and invite to church?

DIGGING DEEPER (Optional)

- (v. 23) Write down how you would help someone know for certain that when they die they will be with Jesus Christ.
- Describe Christ's purpose for you at this time in your life in a couple of sentences. (v. 24)
- In verse 25, Paul said he became *convinced* that he needed to remain on earth. How do you believe he was able to come to that strong of a decision?
- What role can you play in encouraging and motivating joy and faith in those who are in your circles of influence?
- How is the Lord speaking to you as a result of reflecting on this passage today?
