## WEEK 3

## **DAY 14**

Praise (Reflect on what you're grateful for from DAY 13 with the Lord)

Read the text: Philippians 2:25-30 (Jot down key or repeated words and phrases)

Ask questions & interpret the context:

- After reading about Timothy and Epaphrodites, which one do you identify with and why?
- Is there someone you currently know who models Christ to you? How?
- Are there people you can serve in ways you're not doing now?

Summarize: Now take a moment to go back and pour over your observations as well as your responses to the questions.

Engage with God: Bring your thoughts, questions, and desire for change to the Lord for his forgiveness, wisdom, correction, guidance, and direction. Here are some more questions to consider:

- 1. What is the Lord saying to your personally?
- 2. What do you need to pray about?
- 3. With whom does the Lord want you to share this devotional?
- 4. Who has the Lord placed on your heart to pray for and invite to church?

## **DIGGING DEEPER** (Optional)

- Besides calling Epaphrodites his brother (in Christ), Paul also calls him a *fellow worker* and *fellow soldier*. What would you say it the difference between these two types of partnership with Paul for the sake of the Gospel? (v.25) (See also, Philippians 4:3; Romans 16:3; I Thessalonians 3:2)
- What does a ministry of encouragement look like to you in your sphere of influence?
- What opportunities have you taken to minister to friends or loved-ones for which you've long to be with but are not able to?
- Who do choose to honor in your circles of influence?
- How is the Lord speaking to you as a result of reflecting on this passage today?
