25-Day Devotional on Philippians

WEEK 3

DAY 15

Praise (Reflect on what you're grateful for from DAY 14 with the Lord)

Read the text: Philippians 3:1-3 (Jot down key or repeated words and phrases)

Ask questions & interpret the context:

- After reading verses 1-3, why do you think Paul was again motivating his readers to *rejoice in the Lord*? (V.1)
- List some ways the world has tried to draw you into thinking there must be more to achieving salvation than by believing and following Jesus Christ.
- Why do you think self-boasting is antithetical to true spirituality?

Summarize: Now take a moment to go back and pour over your observations as well as your responses to the questions.

Engage with God: Bring your thoughts, questions, and desire for change to the Lord for his forgiveness, wisdom, correction, guidance, and direction. Here are some more questions to consider:

- 1. What is the Lord saying to your personally?
- 2. What do you need to pray about?
- 3. With whom does the Lord want you to share this devotional?
- 4. Who has the Lord placed on your heart to pray for and invite to church?

DIGGING DEEPER (Optional)

- In Biblical history, a Judaizer was one who lived according to Jewish customs and often taught new Gentile believers that salvation was by grace, plus conforming to the Mosaic Law, of which circumcision played a big role. Read Acts 15:1-9; Romans 11:6; Galatians 2:16, 21; 5:1 to understand the contrast between the Truth about Salvation by grace or by grace + something else. (V. 2)
- What does mean to you as a follower of Jesus to be *the circumcision*? (v. 3)
- Describe in your own words what worshipping by the Spirit of God and glory in Christ Jesus mean to you. (V. 3)
- What do you see are the differences between being successful in using your God-given abilities and putting no confidence in the flesh? (V. 3)
- How is the Lord speaking to you as a result of reflecting on this passage today?
