## Living Courageously

25-Day Devotional on Philippians

## WEEK 4

## **DAY 16**

Praise (Reflect on what you're grateful for the weekend with the Lord)

Read the text: Philippians 3:4-9 (Jot down key or repeated words and phrases)

Ask questions & interpret the context:

- Mainstream society has its own boasting built around beauty, brains, brawn and bucks. What are some examples you have observed?
- How have you tripped over yourself by boasting in what you have, what you do, or have done to make yourself look good to others or even God?
- Read verses 7 and 8 again. Why do you think Paul considered his earthly accomplishments as *loss* or *rubbish* in contrast to knowing Jesus?

Summarize: Now take a moment to go back and pour over your observations as well as your responses to the questions.

Engage with God: Bring your thoughts, questions, and desire for change to the Lord for his forgiveness, wisdom, correction, guidance, and direction. Here are some more questions to consider:

- 1. What is the Lord saying to your personally?
- 2. What do you need to pray about?
- 3. With whom does the Lord want you to share this devotional?
- 4. Who has the Lord placed on your heart to pray for and invite to church?

## **DIGGING DEEPER** (Optional)

- Notice that in verses 5-6, Paul describes his pedigree, his position, his works/achievements
  and his conscience. Why do you think this self-description is often a common perspective for
  anyone who is religious but does not know Jesus personally?
- In your own words contrast Paul's view of himself in light of his relationship with Jesus Christ before and after his Damascus Road experience. (See Acts 9:1-22; 22:3-5; 1 Timothy 1:15-16; Titus 3:3-4)
- What does a *surpassing worth* (or value) of knowing Jesus mean to you personally? (V. 8)
- What do you believe is the difference between right living according to your ways versus according to God? (V. 9)
- How is the Lord speaking to you as a result of reflecting on this passage today?
