25-Day Devotional on Philippians

WEEK 4

DAY 19

Praise (Reflect on what you're grateful for from DAY 18 with the Lord)

Read the text: Philippians 3:17- 4:1 (Jot down key or repeated words and phrases)

Ask questions & interpret the context:

- What godly character have you benefited from in others that you'd like to emulate? (v. 17)
- Why do you think pride is at the root of so much of our godlessness? (Vv. 18-19)
- Describe in your own words what it means to you to be a citizen of Heaven. (V. 20)

Summarize: Now take a moment to go back and pour over your observations as well as your responses to the questions.

Engage with God: Bring your thoughts, questions, and desire for change to the Lord for his forgiveness, wisdom, correction, guidance, and direction. Here are some more questions to consider:

- 1. What is the Lord saying to your personally?
- 2. What do you need to pray about?
- 3. With whom does the Lord want you to share this devotional?
- 4. Who has the Lord placed on your heart to pray for and invite to church?

DIGGING DEEPER (Optional)

- What do you believe are key factors in imitating others or following their examples? (Consider I Corinthians 10:1-6; 11:1; John 13:12-15)
- What do you understand is the difference between true follower of Jesus who still battles his/her sin nature and someone who claims to be a follower of Jesus yet do not exhibit the fruits of the Spirit? (See Galatians 5:22-23; Philippians 4:8-9) (Vv. 18-19)
- Describe how the Kingdom of Heaven is here, but not fully here. (V. 20)
- Read Revelation 21:1-27 jotting down key words and phrases about the coming Kingdom of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. (V. 21)
- How do you, as a follower of Jesus, *stand firm* in Him? (4:1)
- How is the Lord speaking to you as a result of reflecting on this passage today?
