## **Re-Radicalized**

Devotional on the Sermon on the Mount

Week 1

## Day 1

Praise (What is it about God's character that I am grateful for?)

Read the text: Matthew 5:3-4 (Jot down words that you want to reflect on)

## Ask questions & interpret the context:

- What does being poor in spirit mean to you? (v. 3)
- When you consider Jesus, what do you think you're in need of? (v. 3)
- What are you brokenhearted over? (v. 4)

Summarize: Now take a moment to go back and pour over your observations as well as your responses to the questions.

Engage with God: Bring your thoughts, questions, and desire for change to the Lord for his forgiveness, wisdom, correction, guidance, and direction.

Extra Questions to Consider

- 1. What is the Lord saying to your personally?
- 2. What do you need to pray about?
- 3. With whom does the Lord want you to share this devotional?
- 4. Who has the Lord placed on your heart to pray for and invite to church?

## **Digging Deeper**

- Do you think verse 3 is referring to those who are economically poor, spiritually poor, or both? And why?
- Consider how Romans 8:18 comes into play with verse 3.
- What spiritual values do you long for or are in need of? (i.e. forgiveness, mercy, kindness, grace, love, truth, honesty and salvation for examples)
- How does it make you feel knowing that the Lord has already anticipated your angst, sorrow or grief through His humanity and ultimately dying for you?
- Read Psalm 51:17 and consider how this verse reflects verse 4.
- What kind of attitude do you desire to put into practice in order to truly experience being as blessed as you are?
