Re-Radicalized Devotional on the Sermon on the Mount

Week 1

Day 3

Praise (Reflect on what you're grateful for from DAY 2 with the Lord)

Read the text: Matthew 5:7-8 (Jot down words that you want to reflect on)

Ask questions & interpret the context:

- Define *mercy* in your own words. (v. 7)
- Determine how you can express mercy to others in your circles of influence.
- Define *pure in heart* in your own words. (v. 8)

Summarize: Now take a moment to go back and pour over your observations as well as your responses to the questions.

Engage with God: Bring your thoughts, questions, and desire for change to the Lord for his forgiveness, wisdom, correction, guidance, and direction.

Extra Questions To Consider

- 1. What is the Lord saying to your personally?
- 2. What do you need to pray about?
- 3. With whom does the Lord want you to share this devotional?
- 4. Who has the Lord placed on your heart to pray for and invite to church?

Digging Deeper

- Read Matthew 18: 21-35. Determine how forgiveness is a powerful expression of mercy toward others.
- Come up with reasons why you think practicing mercy generates the feeling of how blessed you are in Christ.
- In what ways does Ephesians 5:1-2 lead to the development of being merciful?
- How would you practice being pure in heart?
- Read Philippians 4:8 and Romans 12:1-2. Determine how these references lead to being *pure in heart*.
