Re-Radicalized Devotional on the Sermon on the Mount

Week 1

Day 5

Praise (Reflect on what you're grateful for from DAY 4 with the Lord)

Read the text: Matthew 5:11-12 (Jot down words that you want to reflect on)

Ask questions & interpret the context:

- You might not be truly persecuted, but there's certainly the possibility of experiencing false accusations, etc. Has any of this happened to you because you took a stand for the Lord? (v. 11)
- How is it possible to rejoice in the midst of these kinds of oppositions?
- How does it make you feel knowing how much God is on your side? (V. 12)

Summarize: Now take a moment to go back and pour over your observations as well as your responses to the questions.

Engage with God: Bring your thoughts, questions, and desire for change to the Lord for his forgiveness, wisdom, correction, guidance, and direction.

Extra Questions To Consider

- 1. What is the Lord saying to your personally?
- 2. What do you need to pray about?
- 3. With whom does the Lord want you to share this devotional?
- 4. Who has the Lord placed on your heart to pray for and invite to church?

Digging Deeper

- How have you handled a situation in which someone spoke out falsehood against you?
- What scripture comes to mind about handling false accusations? (Consider 1 Peter 3:16; Exodus 20:16; Isaiah 54:17; Proverbs 11:9; 1 Peter 3:9)
- Consider the hope, the blessing, the reward for waiting on the Lord, being patient in affliction and enduring for His sake, not only as you examined verses 3-11, but also here is verse 12.
- Read 1 Peter 1:6-9 and James 1:2-4 and determine how joy can overcome our difficult or terrible circumstances.
- In reflecting back over the week, what how is the Lord speaking to you?
