Read (The Message):

John 13:1-20 ---- ³⁹⁻⁴⁰ Leaving there, he went, as he so often did, to Mount Olives. The disciples followed him. When they arrived at the place, he said, “Pray that you don’t give in to temptation.” ⁴¹⁻⁴⁴ He pulled away from them about a stone’s throw, knelt down, and prayed, “Father, remove this cup from me. But please, not what I want. What do *you* want?” At once an angel from heaven was at his side, strengthening him. He prayed on all the harder. Sweat, wrung from him like drops of blood, poured off his face. ⁴⁵⁻⁴⁶ He got up from prayer, went back to the disciples and found them asleep, drugged by grief. He said, “What business do you have sleeping? Get up. Pray so you won’t give in to temptation.”

1. Why do you think Jesus needed to pray just before His death on the cross?
2. Why do you think He was so strongly pushing the disciples to be in prayer?
3. Why do you think prayer is important?
4. Who do you want to pray for, what do you want to pray about this week? (Consider Matthew 6:9-13)
