

Re-Radicalized Devotional on the Sermon on the Mount

Week 7

Day 34

Praise (Reflect on what you're grateful for from DAY 33 with the Lord)

Read the text: Matthew 6:9-15 (Jot down words that you want to reflect on)

Ask questions & interpret the context:

- **Please see questions and statements to respond to (below) on the Lord's Prayer**

Summarize: Now take a moment to go back and pour over your observations as well as your responses to the questions.

Engage with God: Bring your thoughts, questions, and desire for change to the Lord for his forgiveness, wisdom, correction, guidance, and direction.

Extra Questions To Consider

1. What is the Lord saying to you personally?
2. What do you need to pray about?
3. With whom does the Lord want you to share this devotional?
4. Who has the Lord placed on your heart to pray for and invite to church?

Digging Deeper

- ***Who art in Heaven***
- *In Heaven* shouts out that nothing is outside of God's love, power and care for you.
- What do you think about that?
- Thank Him for holding everything together for you.

Hallowed

- Nothing is more sacred than God.
- Ever thought about any character of God's that affects you?
- Praise Him for those traits.

Be your Name

- Google: *names of God* and think about them for a moment.
- Turn 'em into praise God for who he is to you.

Your Kingdom come

- Ok so, how staggering is it that the almighty God came into our world just to show you how much He loves you?
- Thank the Lord for wanting to come into your life.

Your will be done

- It's not everyday you probably ask someone to take control of your life. But isn't it so comforting to know that God's got you in His hands and without a doubt, knows what's best for you?
- Take a moment to let go and give your life, your day, your moments to God.

On earth as it is in Heaven

- Even though you cannot see Him, do you know that you can truly experience peace and confidence that God is at work in your life?
- How do you want to thank Him for His guidance in your life today?

And forgive us, our trespasses

- How does it make you feel knowing that God forgives any of your sins, be it thoughts or actions?
- What is it that you want to confess to God and ask for His forgiveness?

As we forgive those who trespass against us

- If you think about it, it's pretty powerful, knowing that God gives you the ability and strength to forgive others even when you don't feel like it.
- Is there anyone whom you need to forgive personally or in your heart so that the hurt you've experienced is no longer holding you down or tearing you apart?

And lead us not into temptation

- Have you had felt a "red flag" on a situation or relationship? Consider that God may be protecting you from something or someone that's not right, healthy or godly for you.
- Ask God to give you a discerning spirit today with co-workers, neighbors, friends, or family.

But deliver us from evil

- Do you need God's protection, especially from temptation and sin at this time?
- Ask God to provide you a way out.

For Yours is the Kingdom

- Let's circle back around again and remember what it means that He is God and we are not.
- What is it that you need to give to God for Him to continue to be in charge of your life?

The power and glory

- How awesome is it to know that you such a wonderful and powerful God, who's got your back?
- Take time to praise Him for how His power impacts you.

Forever and ever, amen

- Think about it. You are His child, in His family forever. Nothing can snatch God away from you.
- What do you want to thank Him for today?

Ask or continue to ask the Lord to begin a good work in you (Ephesians 2:10).
