Devotional on the Sermon on the Mount

Week 8

Day 36

Praise (Reflect on what you're grateful for from your weekend with the Lord)

Read the text: Matthew 6:19-21 (Jot down words that you want to reflect on)

Ask questions & interpret the context:

- What are some common "treasures" we pursue in today's world?
- What kind of contrasts in your life to verses 19 & 20 describe?
- What kind of "treasures" do you want in your life to count for eternity?

Summarize: Now take a moment to go back and pour over your observations as well as your responses to the questions.

Engage with God: Bring your thoughts, questions, and desire for change to the Lord for his forgiveness, wisdom, correction, guidance, and direction.

Extra Questions To Consider

1. What is the Lord saying to you personally?
2. What do you need to pray about?
3. With whom does the Lord want you to share this devotional?
4. Who has the Lord placed on your heart to pray for and invite to church?

Digging Deeper

- Why do you think it's instinctive for humans to want to possess "things"?
- Agree or disagree. Why? Wanting something is not sinful.
- What do you love the most? Why?
- What do you think is the difference between obtaining something you want and abusing or misusing something you got? (v. 20)
- What are you "laying up" (or storing in Heaven) that counts for eternity or pleases God?
- Describe the kind of heart you want to have. (v. 21).
