Day 37

Praise (Reflect on what you're grateful for from DAY 36 with the Lord)

Read the text: Matthew 6:22-24 (Jot down words that you want to reflect on)

Ask questions & interpret the context:

- Describe the gift of eyesight in your own words.
- What's better: To be blind and see the Truth or have sight and be blinded to the Truth? Why?
- When and how does money become a "master"?

Summarize: Now take a moment to go back and pour over your observations as well as your responses to the questions.

Engage with God: Bring your thoughts, questions, and desire for change to the Lord for his forgiveness, wisdom, correction, guidance, and direction.

Extra Questions To Consider

1. What is the Lord saying to you personally?
2. What do you need to pray about?
3. With whom does the Lord want you to share this devotional?
4. Who has the Lord placed on your heart to pray for and invite to church?

Digging Deeper

- Compare the eye, which assimilates the light into your body with your heart assimilating the power of God's Word into your life.
- When it comes to your life in Christ, contrast a good eye with an evil eye.
- What do the following references on eyes say to you? Psalm 101:3, 119:18, 37; 1 Samuel 16:7; Matthew 5:28; Proverbs 21:4; Ephesians 1:18.
- Why do you think having one foot in the world and one foot in with the Lord causes you to be divided and not all in with the Lord even if you think you are?
- Describe an undivided heart you want to have for the Lord.
