Devotional on the Sermon on the Mount

Week 2

Day 8

Praise (Reflect on what you're grateful for from DAY 7 with the Lord)

Read the text: Matthew 5:13-16 (Focus: Reflection)

Ask questions & interpret the context:

- What things in life reflect something or someone?
- Describe how you see salt and light being reflective of Jesus.
- Now transfer your description of the reflective nature of salt and light into your life. What does it look like?

Summarize: Now take a moment to go back and pour over your observations as well as your responses to the questions.

Engage with God: Bring your thoughts, questions, and desire for change to the Lord for his forgiveness, wisdom, correction, guidance, and direction.

Extra Questions To Consider

1. What is the Lord saying to you personally?
2. What do you need to pray about?
3. With whom does the Lord want you to share this devotional?
4. Who has the Lord placed on your heart to pray for and invite to church?

Digging Deeper

- What do the following references tell you about being reflective of God? (Genesis 1:26; 12:3; Exodus 19:6; Isaiah 49:6; John 9:5; 12:26; Philippians 2:15)
- Consider how men and women in the Bible, like Moses, Joseph, Abraham, Esther, Hannah, and Lois and Eunice were reflective of God's character. (We encourage you to look them up in Scripture.)
- Think deeply how salt and light are wonderfully reflective agents?
- Remind yourself of the part of God's character (Galatians 5:22-23) that He has enabled you to reflect.
- In what ways can you take your reflection of God's character in your home, workplace, school, neighborhood, community and church?
