Re-Radicalized Devotional on the Sermon on the Mount

Week 2

Day 9

Praise (Reflect on what you're grateful for from DAY 8 with the Lord)

Read the text: Matthew 5:13-16 (Focus: You are salt & light)

Ask questions & interpret the context:

- Make as long of a list as you can think of that salt and light do. (Examples: preserve & illuminate)
- Pick a few of your favorites and describe how they related to your life as a follower of Jesus.
- Take it a step further. How do your same descriptions of salt and light play a role in how you make a change in others for Jesus?

Summarize: Now take a moment to go back and pour over your observations as well as your responses to the questions.

Engage with God: Bring your thoughts, questions, and desire for change to the Lord for his forgiveness, wisdom, correction, guidance, and direction.

Extra Questions To Consider

- 1. What is the Lord saying to your personally?
- 2. What do you need to pray about?
- 3. With whom does the Lord want you to share this devotional?
- 4. Who has the Lord placed on your heart to pray for and invite to church?

Digging Deeper

- "You are..." There is no plan B. You are God's Purpose, Ambassador and Plan. How does this make you feel?
- Why do you think it is so critical how we live as much as it is what we say?
- Salt is potent. Compare that to a follower of Jesus going against the tide of worldly influence.
- Salt provides flavor. Compare that to a follower of Jesus' impact on the meaning of life.
- Light, in Scripture, mostly speaks of truth and righteousness with a continuous glow. Why do you suppose light does that, particularly the light that shines in followers of Jesus?
- What would do you imagine it looking like if everyone in our church became missional: salt & light?
- Who do you want to be salt & light to?
