Devotional on the Sermon on the Mount

Week 3

Day 13

Praise (Reflect on what you're grateful for from DAY 12 with the Lord)

Read the text: Matthew 6:9-10

Ask questions & interpret the context:

- Think about it. God can be called Father or daddy!
- How do you feel about having a close relationship with the almighty Creator of the universe?
- Just thinking about God, (His name), what do you want to praise Him for?
- What's even better, God came to you to show how much He loves you and that He wants to be your Guide throughout your life. What do you need to turn over to Him for Him to take control?

Summarize: Now take a moment to go back and pour over your observations as well as your responses to the questions.

Engage with God: Bring your thoughts, questions, and desire for change to the Lord for his forgiveness, wisdom, correction, guidance, and direction.

Extra Questions To Consider

1. What is the Lord saying to your personally?
2. What do you need to pray about?
3. With whom does the Lord want you to share this devotional?
4. Who has the Lord placed on your heart to pray for and invite to church?

Digging Deeper

- Take a moment to reflect on God being your Father in Scripture: I John 3:1; Isaiah 9:6; Psalms 103:13; Proverbs 3:11-12; Matthew 6:26; John 17:24, 14:23.
- What do you observe about the Psalmists' reverence of God: Psalm 7:17, 8:1,9; 20:1, 33:21, 80:18, 72:19 and 135:13.
- What kind of impact does the prayer for *His Kingdom to come* have on you right now? (Socially, physically, intellectually, morally and spiritually)
- What does it mean to you that God's Kingdom is here (Matthew 4:17; Luke 17:21), but not yet (Luke 19:11-12)?
- In what ways is *God's will being done* in your life today?
