## Devotional on the Sermon on the Mount

Week 7

### Day 33

Praise (Reflect on what you're grateful for from DAY 32 with the Lord)

Read the text: Matthew 6:5-13 (Jot down words that you want to reflect on)

Ask questions & interpret the context:

- What does hypocrisy in prayer look like to you?
- Have you ever prayed to get a pat on the back and a big thank you?
- What do you think you ought to do to learn to pray more deeply and more effectively?

Summarize: Now take a moment to go back and pour over your observations as well as your responses to the questions.

Engage with God: Bring your thoughts, questions, and desire for change to the Lord for his forgiveness, wisdom, correction, guidance, and direction.

#### Extra Questions To Consider

1. What is the Lord saying to you personally?
2. What do you need to pray about?
3. With whom does the Lord want you to share this devotional?
4. Who has the Lord placed on your heart to pray for and invite to church?

#### Digging Deeper

- When or how does prayer become less about our focus on the Lord and more about how we feel or others feel about us?
- Agree or disagree and why? Position or posture matters when it comes to praying.
- Why do you think the Lord's prayer is a good model?
- How do you think passages, like the Lord's Prayer, can become more personal and less mundane?
- Consider these Psalm as models for developing your prayer life: 4, 8, 22, 32, 42, 51 and 91.
- Ask or continue to ask the Lord to begin a good work in you (Ephesians 2:10).
