Week of Sept 27, 2021

Ice-breaker

What sort of excuses to people come up with for their mistakes, sin, etc.?

Read James 1:13-18

- Can you think of any reason why we tend to blame God, who's not the author of temptations, or even others for almost anything that goes wrong in our lives? (v. 13)
- Even though God does not temp us, do you think He allows it? Why, or why not?
- What does the phrase, and He Himself tempts no one, tell you about God's intent for your life? (See James 1:17-18; Genesis 22:1; Judges 2:22; 2 Kings 20:12-19; 2 Chronicles 32:31)
- Take verses 14 & 15 and come to an understanding of how you may have fallen into downward spiral to sin through one of your own life's experiences.
- Compare Proverbs 14:12 with John 14:6 as it pertains to James 1:14-15.
- Draw a conclusion on the word, **death**, that James speaks of, in verse 15.
- Going back to verses 17-18, find as many reasons as you can as to why there's no need to doubt God's goodness.
- Take a moment to identify any area(s) of weakness, in which you might be easily tempted to sin. How can you live differently as a follower of Jesus?
