Ice-breaker

Have you ever been burned by a phony Christian? (Nic Gilmour)

Read James 2:14-26

- Compare Paul's focus on faith, grace and works in Ephesians 2:8-10 with verses 14-17.
- Why do you think the Lord is telling you, through James, that your faith is useless (dead) without godly action (obedience)? (v.17)
- According to verses 18-20, James was arguing again that a marriage exists between faith and works, not for salvation, but for following Jesus. How would you develop a link between these verses and Galatians 5:22-23?
- Is it possible for your friend or family member to be saved (a friend of God) even if he/she does not practice good deeds in obedience to Christ? (v.23)
- In view of verse 24, contrast faith that remains as knowledge, to faith that moves to the heart, bearing fruit (John 15).
- Consider Abraham and Rahab (vs. 20-26), how are you revealing and demonstrating your faith in and through your works?
