Memory Verse: James 1:19-20

Ice-breaker

What do you suppose is the difference between anger and frustration?

Read James 1:19-27

- Keeping verse 18 in mind, what do the words, quick to hear, mean to you?
- Look up Proverbs 10:19; 11:12; 15:1 and 17:28 to develop an understanding of how a lack of tuning into God's Word, along with thoughtless talk, often leads to ungodly and selfish attitudes.
- Why do you suppose anger is in such opposition to God's purpose for our lives? (v.20)
- Check out Romans 13:12, Ephesians 4:22 and Colossians 3:8 to get a taste of what James is dipping into with the words, *put away all filthiness* and *rampant wickedness*. (v.21)
- Describe the marriage of listening and obeying (doers of the Word).
- What is the process in your mind by which you can move from deaf ears to active listening that leads to surrender?
- From verse 25, describe in your own words why a follower of Jesus is blessed.
- How do you see verses like 1 John 2:15-17, John 17:13-28 and Romans 12:2 relating to James' words to keep oneself unstained by the world (v.27)
