Memory Verse: James 5:16

Ice-breaker: Describe a time in which prayer made a difference in your life.

Read James 5:1-11

- 1. Make a list and discuss all the aspects of prayer that you see James touching on in this section.
- 2. What have you experienced in your life and in those around you as a typical response to times of trouble?
- 3. What do you see Psalm 30, 50:15 and 91:5 saying about responding to trouble?
- 4. Describe how singing and praying can be one and the same. (See 1 Corinthians 14:15; Ephesians 5:19; Colossians 3:16)
- 5. How would you desire to apply verse 14, anointing and prayer for the sick in the context of your small group or close circle of friends/family?
- 6. How do you strike a balance between your faith (which is a gift from God Ephesians 2:8) and God's plan for your life? (v.15)
- 7. Why do you think the Lord, through James, is asking you and me to be a confessing community?
- 8. According to the following references, think about what you believe truth is: John 3:21; 8:31-32; 16:13; 18:37; Galatians 5:7; Ephesians 4:15; 2 Thessalonians 2:10; 1 John 3:18-19.
- 9. Create a loving scenario working on bringing a friend back from a departure of the faith.
- 10. What has this study of the Book of James reminded you of or opened your heart and mind to?
