General Description

• Assists with a particular age group of children and its volunteers during the Kingdom Kids program whose goal is to provide a safe place where children are nurtured and discipled, giving moms the opportunity to participate in Women's Bible study.

Specific Duties and Responsibilities

- Classroom
 - Makes sure that assigned classroom for age group is neat, clean, and set up before parents & children arrive
 - o Stocks classroom with necessary resources to complete program schedule
 - Responsible for disinfecting toys at end of program and storing the way were found
- During Program
 - $\circ\;$ Works with parents to provide a smooth transition for children entering the classroom
 - o Carries out drop-off and pick-up activities to keep kids busy and organized
 - Always sure of number of children in class, periodically recounting especially before and after going in and out of room
 - Must be able to work Tuesday's from 8:30am-12:30pm, other childcare opportunities available also on other days or evenings

- The developmental milestones of children aged infant to 5 years old
- · Age-appropriate child care, play, and activities
- State laws and ratios regarding childcare

Work Environment
