When DARKNESS STRIKES... WHEN WE CANNOT SEE...

24 Now **Thomas** (also known as Didymus - *i.e Twin*), <u>one of the Twelve</u> was not with the disciples when Jesus came.

Thomas "Crisis of Faith - Who was Thomas? He was...

- <u>Disciple</u> Prayed for, Called, Chosen, Trained, First-Hand Witness...
- Luke 6:12-13 "One of those days <u>Jesus went out to the mountainside to pray</u>, and spent the night <u>praying to God</u>. When the morning came <u>he called his disciples</u> to him <u>and chose the</u> <u>twelve of them</u>, whom he also designated as disciples.
- <u>Dedicated</u> Left All to Follow & Was Willing to die!
- John 11:16 Then Thomas (also known as Didymus) said to the rest of the disciples, <u>"Let us also</u> got that we may die with him."
- <u>Determined</u> Bold to Ask Questions... He wants to know...
- John 14:5-6 Thomas said to him, "Lord, we don't know where you are going, so how can we know the way?" Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." -
- <u>Doubting</u> "Unless I see... I will not believe."

25 So the other disciples told him, "<u>We have seen the Lord!</u>" But he said to them, <u>Unless I see</u> the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, <u>I will</u> not believe."

• Thomas : Dashed Hope, Unmet Expectations, He is Struck by Grief.

Have You Wrestled with Doubts? Listen to the Words of David!!

- **Psalm 10:1** Why, Lord, do you stand far off? Why do you hide yourself in times of trouble?
- **Psalm 13:1** How long, Lord? Will you forget me forever? How long will you hide your face from me?
- **Psalm 22:1** My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?

John 20:25 So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord!"

1. THOMAS IS CONFRONTED WITH THE APOSTLES WORD.

- The Apostles Words are Trustworthy Words.
- Acts 1:3 After his suffering, he presented himself to them and gave many convincing proofs that he was alive.
- The Early Church was DEVOTED Apostles word.
- Acts 2:42 They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

2.THOMAS IS CONFRONTED WITH JESUS' WORD.

John 20:26 A week later his disciples were in the house again, and Thomas was with them. Though the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, <u>"Peace be with you!"</u> (Gods Will for Thomas and His People is Peace!!)

Peace (eirēnē) - tranquility, safety, peace between individuals, salvation

• A <u>Promised</u> Peace, A <u>Relational</u> Peace (w/God & Others), An <u>Eternal Peace</u> that Surpasses understanding! (Is 9:6, Jn 14:27, Ro 5:1-2, Ph 4:7)

27 "Stop doubting and believe" - (The Heart of the Problem in the Garden)

- Doubting (Apistos) Be not unfaithful, faithless, not believing without trust, untrusting.
- Believe (Pistos) Have Faith, Believe, Be Faithful, Be a Believer, Be Certain (Jesus is Risen)

"Doubt, though concerned with facts, is not primarily about them, but rather about our emotional sensational connection, security and confidence." - Dr. Curt Thompson (Soul of Shame)

- DOUBT IS A RELATIONAL PROBLEM - Can I still trust???

- Doubt is the Seed to Shame, and Shame brings separation from God and others.
- Genesis 3:1 the serpent, crafty said... "Did God really say????
- Genesis 3:7... "they knew they were naked. And sewed fig leaves.

Jesus is addressing the sin at its core... "Don't doubt, believe Thomas!"

WHAT DO WE DO WHEN DOUBT ARISES? BEHOLD HIS WORD!

• Romans 10:17 - Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God! (NKJV)

When WE CANNOT SEE : Behold



His Wounds

27 Then he said to Thomas, "**Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side**. Stop doubting and believe."

Behold My Wounds... WHY? THERE IS HEALING! (Read Isaiah 53:5)

Isaiah 53:5 - But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and **by his wounds we are healed**.

• Healed (Rapa) to mend (by stitching), to cure (cause to) heal, to repair, thoroughly, make whole.

- JESUS RELATES TO US IN OUR SUFFERING. The best man to ever live getting the worst suffering ever invented!

- GOD MEETING THOMAS IN DARK MOMENT

- Tapestry Photos Life is is A Tapestry (2 Sides to Reality).
- The Weaving (Corrie Ten Boom)

My life is but a weaving, Between my God and me. I cannot choose the colors He weaveth steadily.

Oft' times He weaveth sorrow; And I in foolish pride, Forget He sees the upper, And I the underside.

Not 'til the loom is silent, And the shuttles cease to fly, Will God unroll the canvas, And reveal the reason why.

The dark threads are as needful, In the weaver's skillful hand, As the threads of gold and silver, In the pattern He has planned.

When WE CANNOT SEE : Behold <u>His Worthiness</u>



28 Thomas said to him, "My Lord and my God!"

- Lord (kyrios) to whom one belongs, has power; master, lord, owner, sovereign prince, possessor.
- God (theos) God, of Godhead, Deity, Divine Nature, Person, Power

"Thomas like a good historian, wants to see and touch. Jesus presents himself to his sight and invites him to touch, but Thomas doesn't. He transcends the type of knowing he had intended to use and passes into a higher and richer one... **Thomas takes a deep breath and brings history and faith together in a rush."** -**N.T. Wright (Surprised by Hope)**

THOMAS DECLARES HIS WORTHINESS - WHAT IS WORSHIP?

• John 4:24 God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth."

Paul used 3 words to describe worship.

- Proskuneo "pay homage' "to fall down" or "bow down before." (1 Corinthians 14:25)
- Sebázomai "to render honor" (Romans 1:25)
- Sébomai "to revere or adore" (Acts 16:4)

MORE THAN A SONG

 Romans 12:1 - Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to <u>offer your bodies</u> as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—<u>this is your true and proper worship</u>.

29 Then Jesus told him, "Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."
