General Description

• The Global Mission Coordinator will mobilize the congregation to live missionally by equipping, inspiring, and leading North Coast Calvary Chapel in discipleship, justice, evangelism, and service to the world. This role will foster strong partnerships with Global mission organizations and partners and ensure the church remains deeply engaged in God's mission across cultures and communities.

Key Responsibilities

- Equip & inspire church members for Global service opportunities and short-term mission trips.
- Support the Mision Impact Team on projects and events (Serve Day, Unite Luncheon).
- Provide training in cross-cultural engagement, justice, evangelism, and discipleship principles.
- Coordinate logistics for mission trips, including budgets, travel, training, and debrief sessions.
- Manage mission budgets, expense reports, and partner support allocations.
- Work with Mission Ambassadors and Global Mission Partners to identify, create and communicate opportunities to mobilize NCCC community to volunteer
- Maintain and strengthen relationships with mission partners, agencies, and global organizations.
