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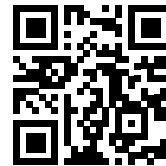

As we look ahead to 2026, we do so with faith and anticipation. God is not done — He is continuing to renew His church, our community, and each of us.

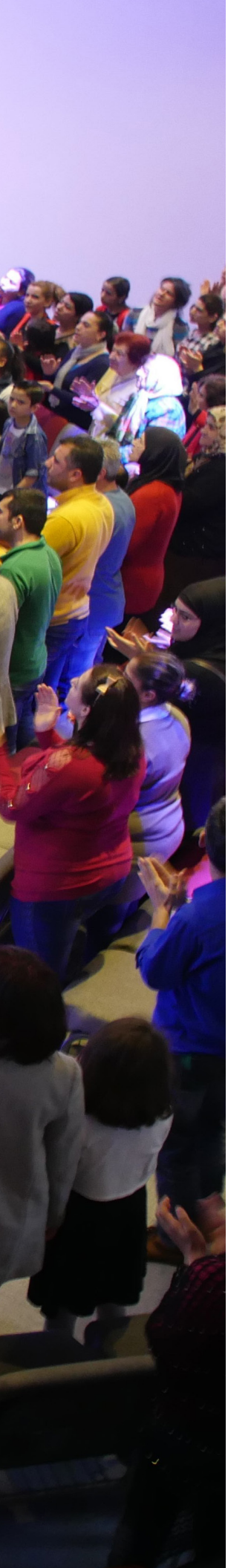

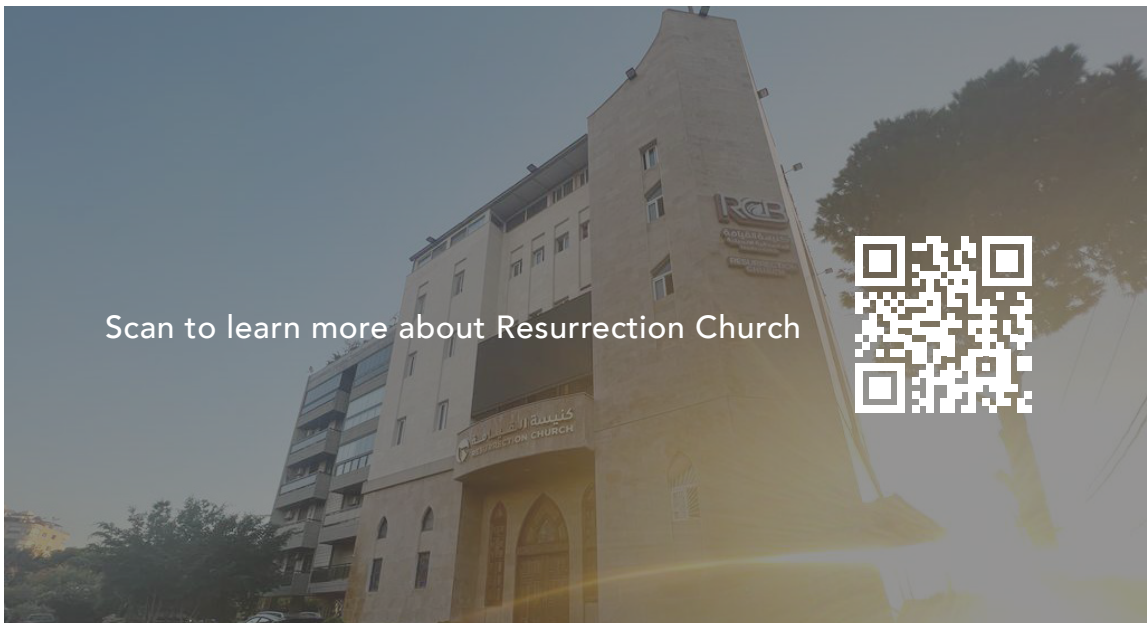

Making a Local Impact

El Camino High School Wellness Center & Teacher's Lounge

Through God's grace and the generosity of our church family, North Coast Calvary Chapel partnered with Bottom Line and Unite North County to bless El Camino High School with two transformative new spaces: a Student Wellness Center and a Teacher's Lounge.

The Student Wellness Center is a safe, welcoming space where students can find counseling, support, and a place to unwind when life or school gets challenging. The Teacher's Lounge was designed with a "coffee shop vibe," giving staff a much-needed place to relax, recharge, and connect with one another. These spaces are more than just rooms — they are tangible expressions of care, showing students and teachers alike that our community values them.

Volunteers from Bottom Line and Unite North County poured their time, talent, and resources into the project — from architectural design and planning to furniture and finishing touches — all pro bono. One volunteer shared,

"The reason why the kids are here is because there's a need for that service. It means so much to them, and it's just a few hours of your time and your gifts. For us, it's about people coming together for a greater good."

This project was a true collaboration of hearts and hands, bringing together business leaders, church members, and community partners to serve a common purpose: showing God's love through practical action. The result is a lasting impact on both students and staff, creating environments where wellness, care, and encouragement flourish.

Through partnerships like this, we're reminded that God calls us to love our neighbors in tangible ways — and when we do, our city is transformed, one life at a time.

Baptism symbolizes Christ's death, burial, and resurrection, marking new life in Him. From children to seniors, we've seen the Holy Spirit move across every generation in our church.

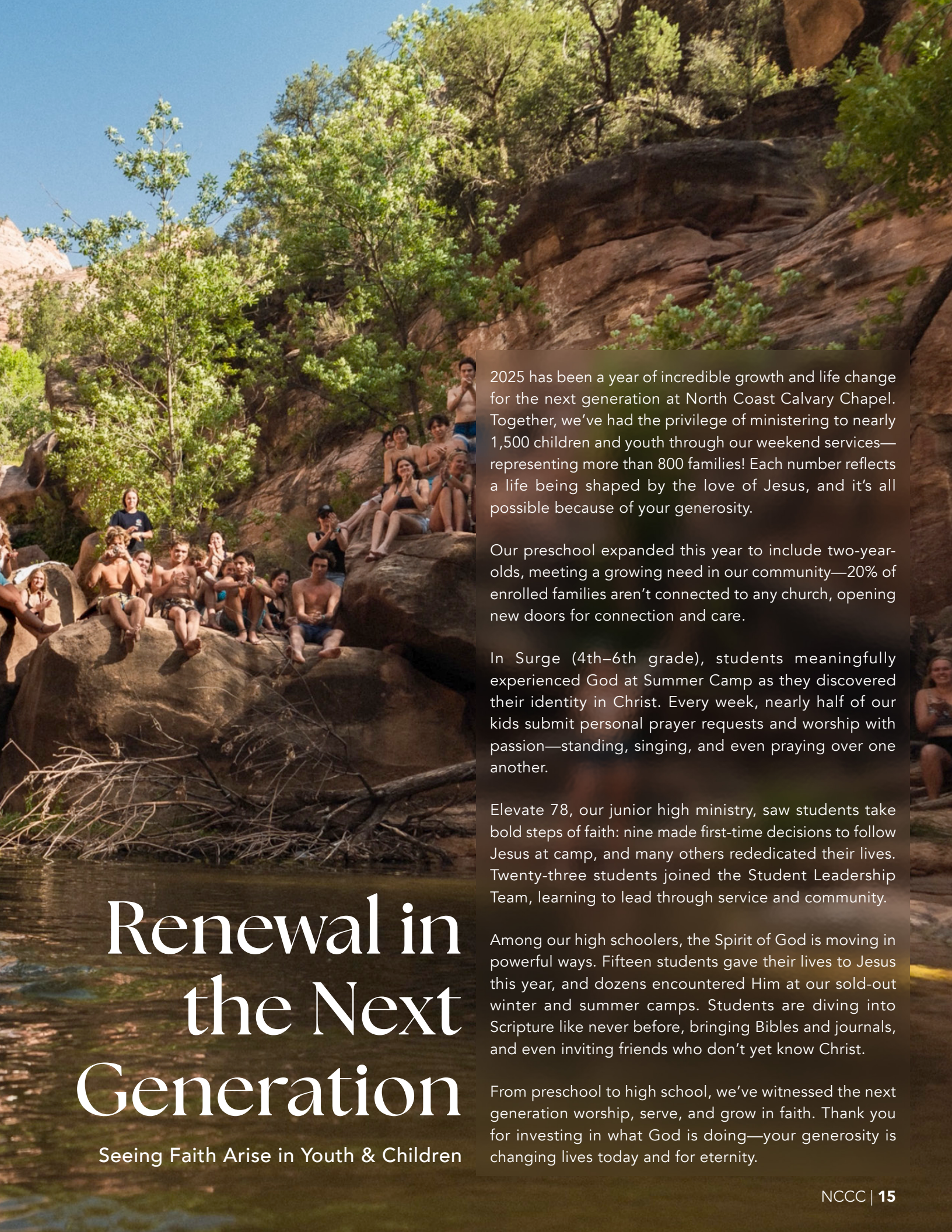
One family shared about their daughter, Colette:

Renewal in the Next Generation

Seeing Faith Arise in Youth & Children

2025 has been a year of incredible growth and life change for the next generation at North Coast Calvary Chapel. Together, we've had the privilege of ministering to nearly 1,500 children and youth through our weekend services—representing more than 800 families! Each number reflects a life being shaped by the love of Jesus, and it's all possible because of your generosity.

Our preschool expanded this year to include two-year-olds, meeting a growing need in our community—20% of enrolled families aren't connected to any church, opening new doors for connection and care.

In Surge (4th–6th grade), students meaningfully experienced God at Summer Camp as they discovered their identity in Christ. Every week, nearly half of our kids submit personal prayer requests and worship with passion—standing, singing, and even praying over one another.

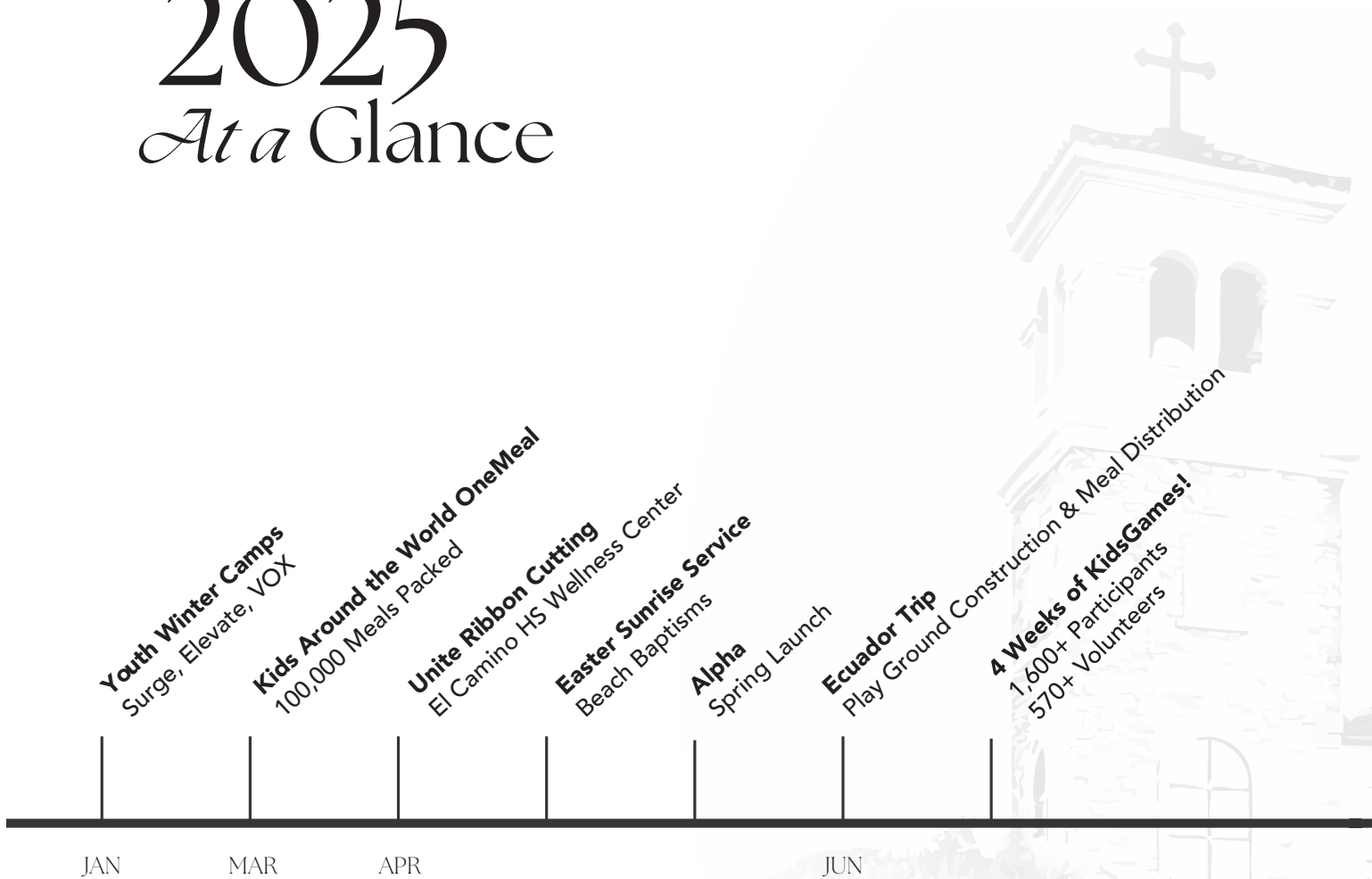
Elevate 78, our junior high ministry, saw students take bold steps of faith: nine made first-time decisions to follow Jesus at camp, and many others rededicated their lives. Twenty-three students joined the Student Leadership Team, learning to lead through service and community.

Among our high schoolers, the Spirit of God is moving in powerful ways. Fifteen students gave their lives to Jesus this year, and dozens encountered Him at our sold-out winter and summer camps. Students are diving into Scripture like never before, bringing Bibles and journals, and even inviting friends who don't yet know Christ.

From preschool to high school, we've witnessed the next generation worship, serve, and grow in faith. Thank you for investing in what God is doing—your generosity is changing lives today and for eternity.
