## KIDSGAMES JUNIORS (4 & 5 YR OLDS)

*Camp Hours: 8:45 AM - 12:15 PM*

KidsGames Juniors is our uniquely crafted program for our small and mighty campers aged 4 and 5 year olds (PRE-K/Kindergarten) with a curriculum written just for them! Our Junior campers rotate daily to each of the five zones: Bible Storytelling/Worship, Creative Zone, Sports Zone, Outdoor Adventure Zone and our NEW indoor KidsGames City!

### BIBLE STORY/LARGE GROUP WORSHIP

During Bible story and worship, our Junior campers will come together to learn more about the character of God, hear the stories of His miracles and learn more about the promises He keeps. Through dance and worship, campers will also learn songs reminding them of God's love for them!

### CREATIVE ZONE

Campers will use painting, drawing, stamping, and other forms of creative expression to gain a deeper understanding of the daily Bible stories they hear at camp. Our campers will be inspired and encouraged to share what they're learning with those around them.

### SPORTS ZONE

Our campers will get active, healthy, and happy in our Sports Zone! Each day our campers will team up with our Coaches and Group Guides and practice fun drills to learn basic skills in a variety of sports and activities such as soccer, baseball, relay games, and more!

### OUTDOOR ADVENTURE ZONE

Campers engage in an interactive outdoor play space where imagination and discovery come to life! Little adventurers can dig for "fossils" in the sand pit, zoom around the raceway, experiment at the water tables, and more. This hands-on, sensory-rich environment encourages creative play, movement, and curiosity in a fun and safe setting.

### KIDSGAMES CITY

KidsGames City is a miniature, interactive world where children can explore, imagine, and learn through hands-on experiences. Designed to mimic a real city, this immersive environment allows kids to step into real-world roles, from community helpers to business owners, all while engaging their curiosity and creativity.

# 1ST-6TH GRADE PROGRAM

Campers will spend time with their peers and trained Team Guide engaging in creative play, friendly and competitive sports games, fellowship, Bible storytelling and amazing worship each day!

Campers are placed on one of eight color Teams based on grade level (1st-3rd grade Teams and 4th-6th grade Teams). For accountability, safety and building rapport with Team Guides, campers are then assigned to a smaller group of 8 within their Team.

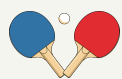

## OTHER FAQs

### What is your cancellation policy?

Full refunds are available if canceled before May 7. No refunds will be issued after May 7, but the option to transfer your registration to a friend or family member is available.

### Can my camper be grouped with friends at KidsGames?

We do our best to group campers together with at least one friend as long as they are the same gender and in the same grade range. We have separate small groups for boys and girls. To make a friend request for your camper, please do so on the camper registration form. Our small group format fosters creating friendships and a welcoming environment where every camper feels safe and included.

### What is your cell phone policy?

Please refrain from bringing any cell phones to kidsgames. Campers and Volunteers carrying cell phones will be asked to turn them off and put them away during program hours. KidsGames will not be responsible for lost or stolen phones brought to camp.

### When do I find out my child's group placement?

You will receive information about your child's team color and the t-shirt/wristband pickup dates so you can be ready for camp!

*One Week Before Your Camp Week:* You will receive an email with your camper's assigned small group (team color and group letter), along with any important final reminders to help you prepare.

### What should my child wear/bring to camp?

Campers should arrive each day wearing their KidsGames shirt and closed-toe shoes, and bring a labeled water bottle (first and last name). A mid-morning snack is provided; however, if your child has allergy concerns, we recommend packing a snack from home. Wristbands provided at check-in must be worn by campers at all times.

### What should my camper bring for Water Day on Thursdays?

Campers should arrive wearing a swimsuit under their clothes (one-piece or rash guard with shorts), along with shoes they don't mind getting wet. Please also bring a towel and sunscreen.
